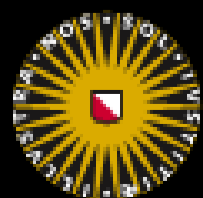
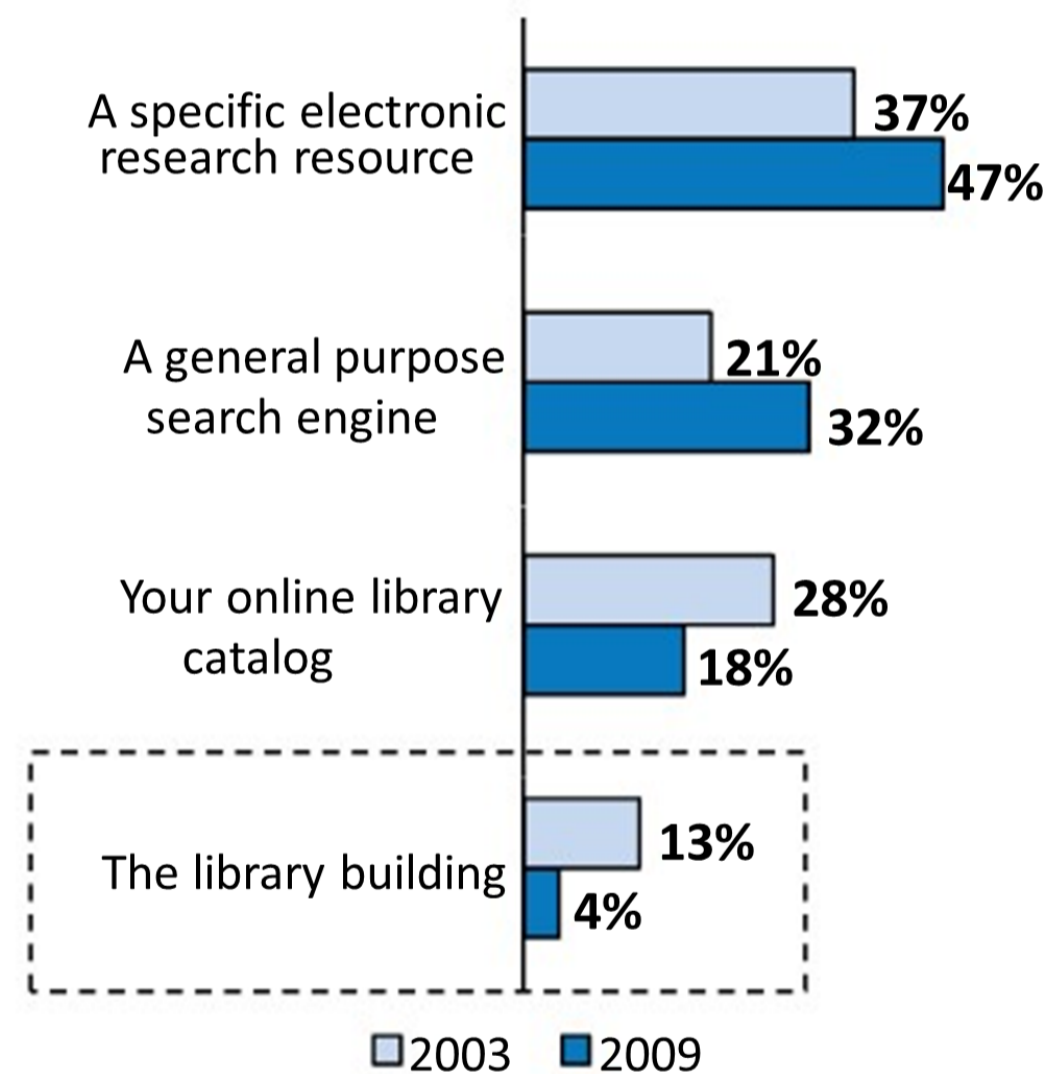
Where Do Students Start a Search?

n = 2,229

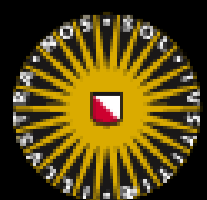
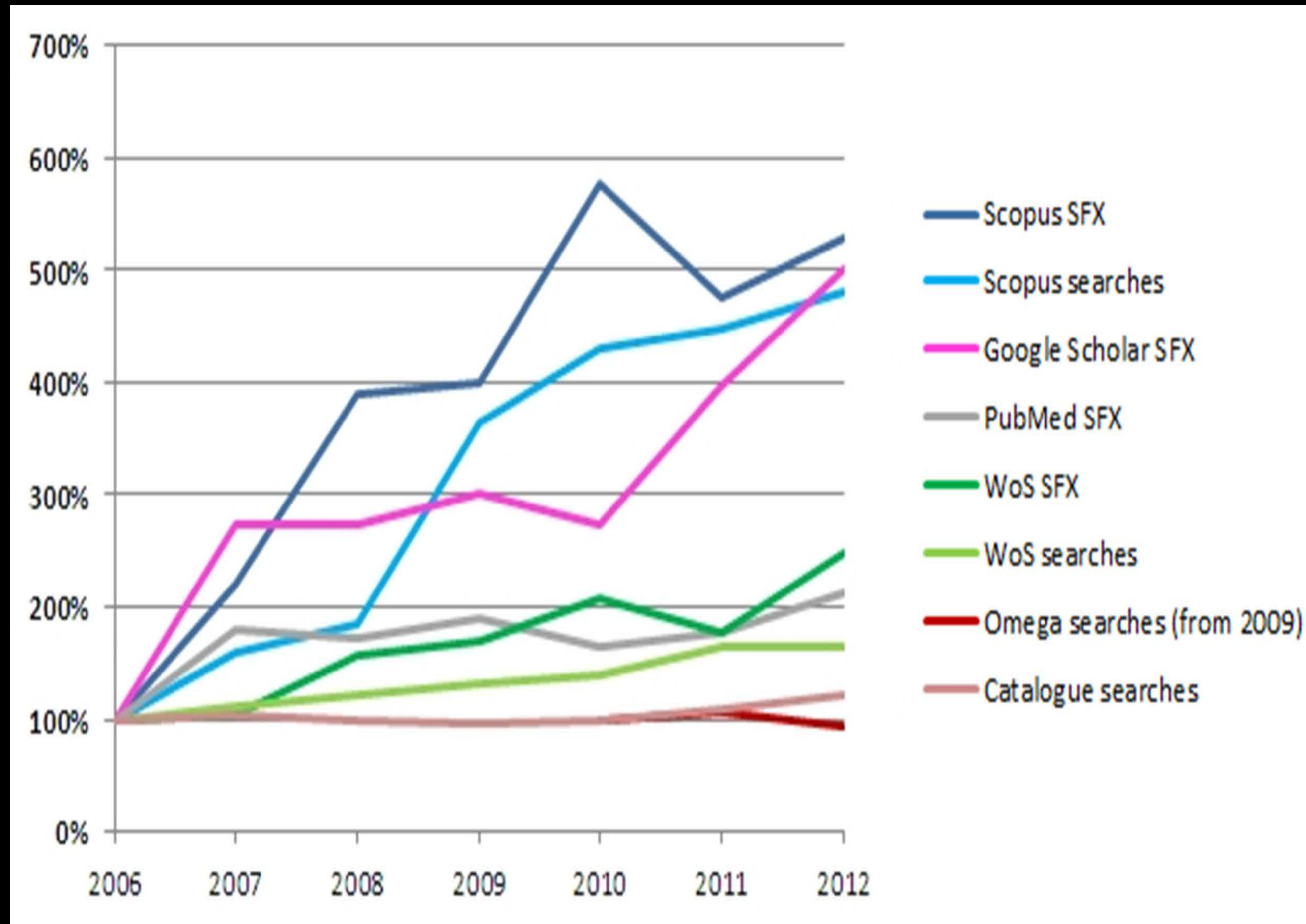


Where Do Faculty Start Their Research?

n = 3,025



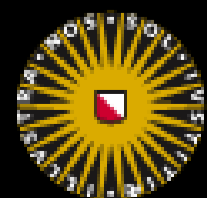
Trend search behaviour Utrecht University, 2012

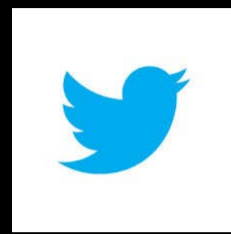

We intend to address the questions of what drives innovation and how these innovations change research workflows and may contribute to more open, efficient and good science.

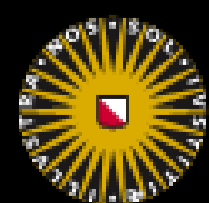
