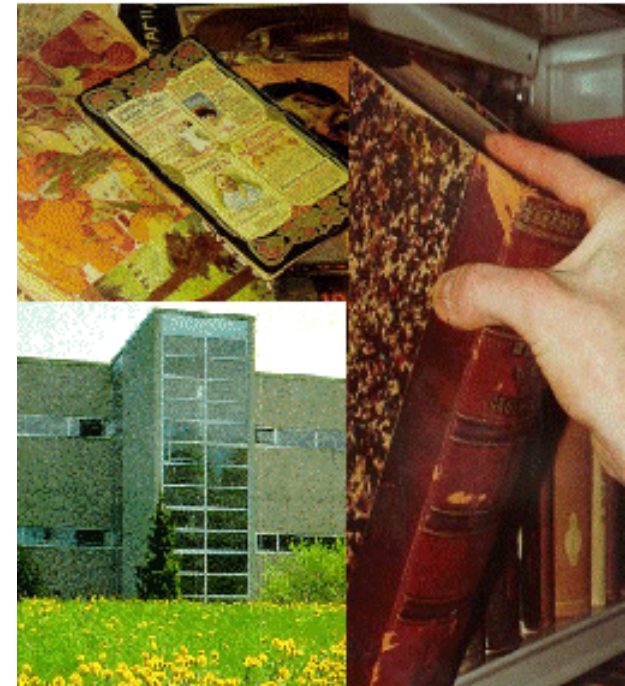

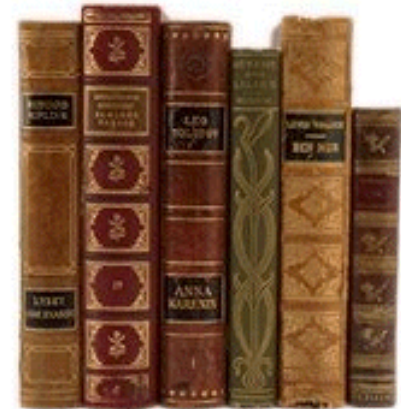

National Collection Policy - 1

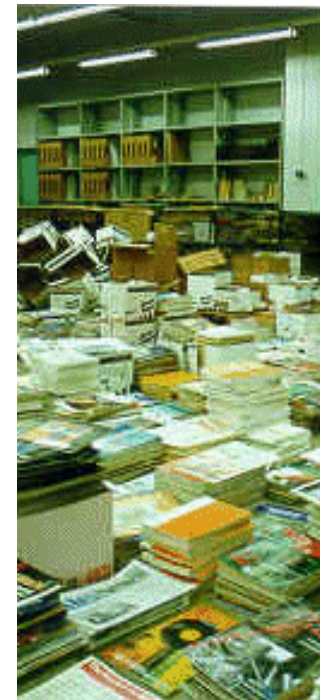
- goal: national self-reliance
- elements:
 - National Library (Fennica)
 - subject responsibility libraries
 - National Repository Library (-1989)
- acquisition: 15 shelf kilometres





National Collection Policy - 2

- Access to global information
- local level: profiled collections
- collaborative level: NRL / FinELib
 - bibliographic information
 - collection resources
- NRL for print material





Services to libraries

- deduplicated collections (49/82 km); 2,5 million items, growing
- monographs, serials, dissertations
- all languages
- 15 % of combined university library collections
- 1,6 % of university library budgets
- 6,8 % of acquisition budgets
