

## Getting to and around Florence

### Arriving in Florence

Florence is easily reached by plane, train or car. The city has its own international [airport](#) (Amerigo Vespucci) and [Pisa International Airport](#) is just 50 km away. Florence is a major high-speed railway hub with trains leaving regularly for the whole of Italy. Florence is located on the main Italian motorway, the A1, which connects Milan and Naples.

The city's [Destination Florence website](#) provides comprehensive information about arriving in Florence. Train tickets may be purchased through service providers [Trenitalia](#) and [Italo](#), or [The Trainline](#).

### Shuttle service

A private bus will be available each morning, both from the centre of Florence ([Piazza dell'Unità Italiana](#)) and from the centre of Fiesole ([Piazza Mino](#)); a shuttle service will also be provided for the return journey.

Bus transfers will be provided from the European University Institute to the evening reception at Villa La Torrossa and the conference dinner at Grand Hotel Baglioni.

### Bus and tram

The city has a useful public transport network, managed by [Autolinee Toscane](#). Tickets cover both bus and tram, but printed tickets must be validated using the machines on board at the start of your journey. A single ticket costs Euro 1.70, while it is also possible to buy a multiple-ride ticket (10 journeys) for the slightly reduced price of Euro 15.50; these must be kept intact and may be used by one person only.

In addition to ticket offices and machines, tickets can be bought at some retailers - look for the T symbol outside - as well as through the [app](#) and by contactless payment on the bus or tram (one card is required for each ticket).

### Travelling by taxi

There are two taxi companies in Florence and many taxi ranks around the city centre, including one at the station, in Piazza del Duomo and in piazza San Marco. They can be reached on the following numbers: (+39) 055 4242 and (+39) 055 4390.

Both companies also offer apps which can be used to find taxis. These are available for free download at [apptaxi.it](#) and [taximove.it](#), as well as from the Google and Apple app stores.
